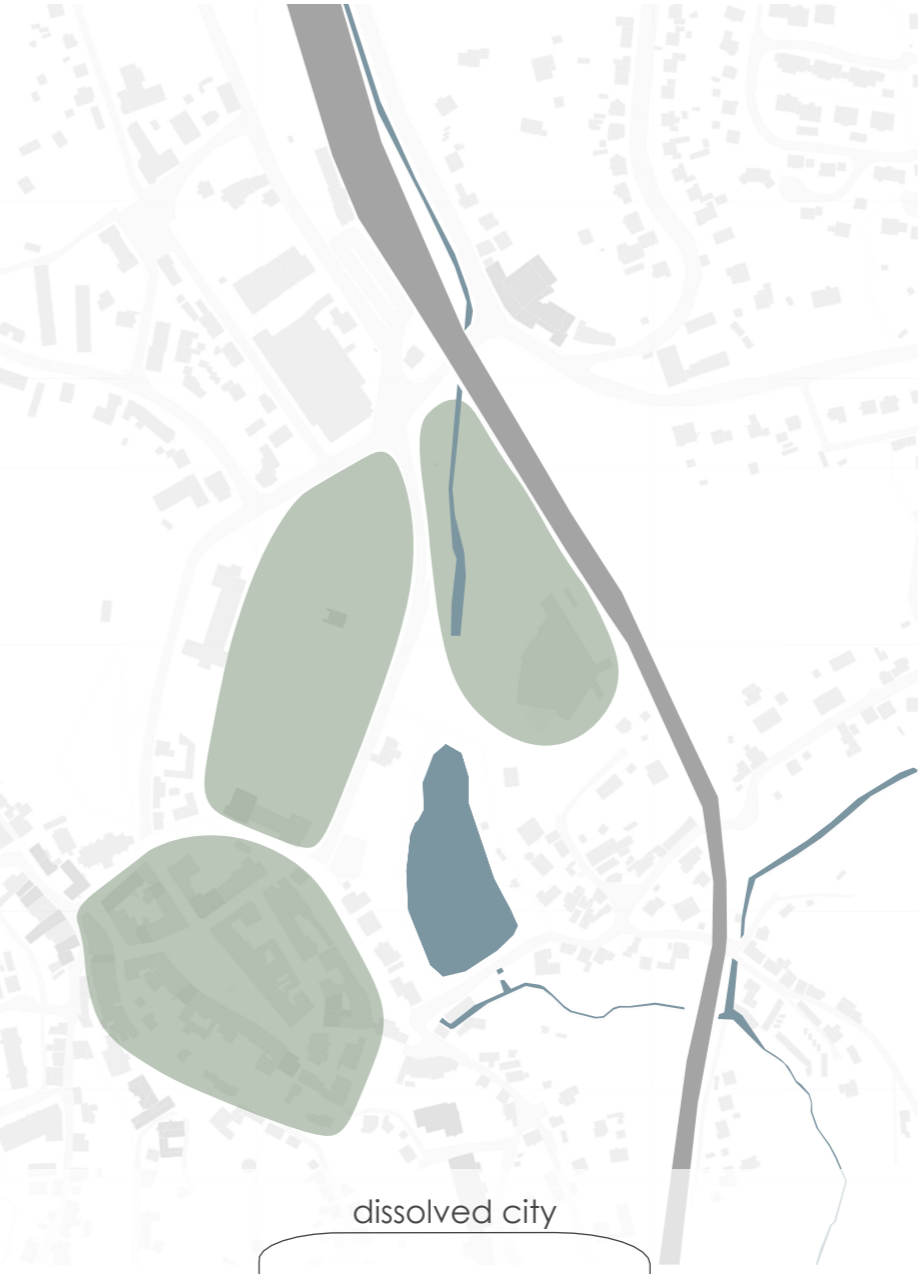

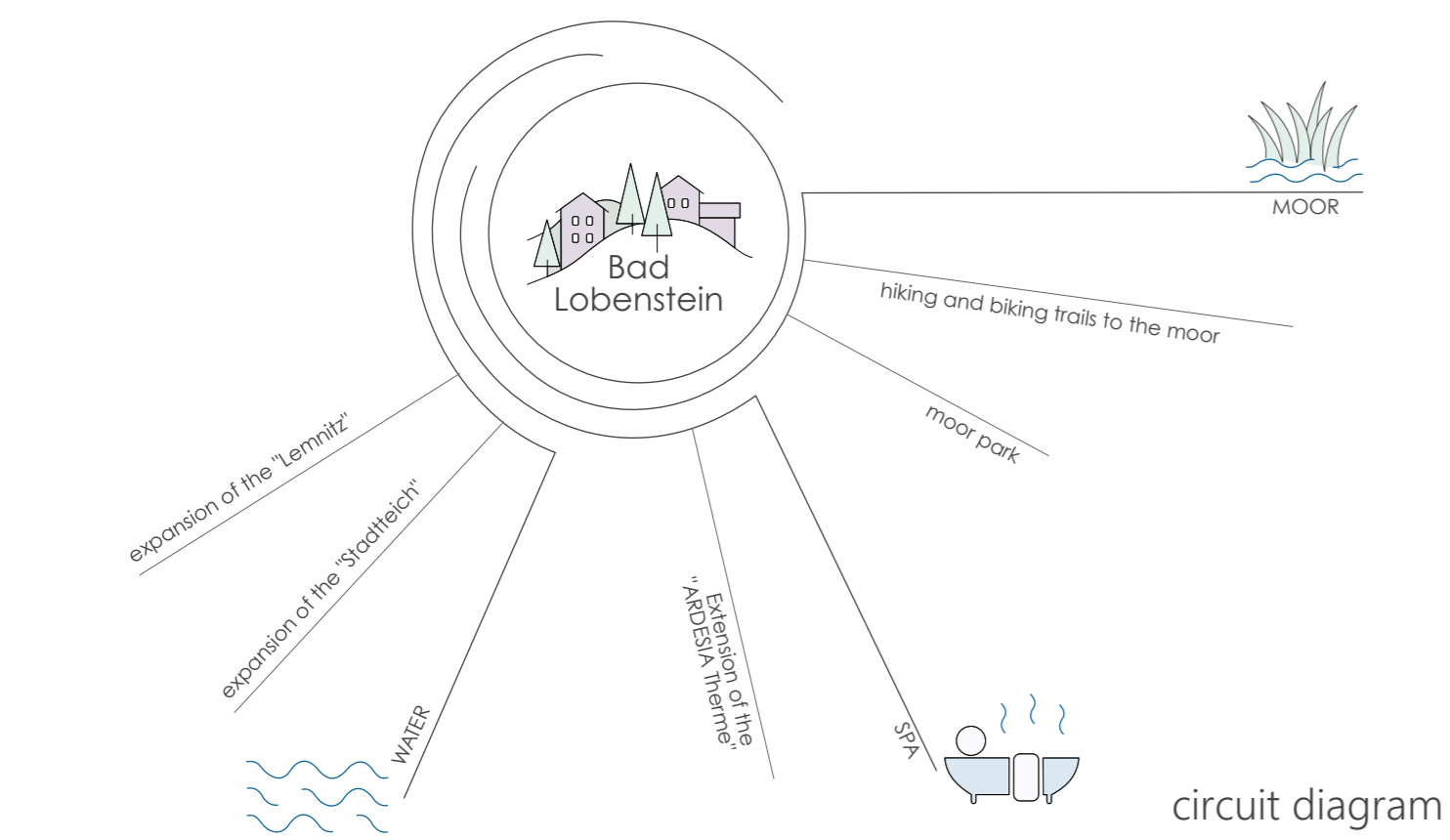

The first solution is expanding the ARDESIA thermal baths, which ensures that their importance is enhanced. By using both landscape and architectural elements, both existing and new, the thermal baths become more important in the streetscape and the city lives up to its name. Furthermore connection is key, so visitors are guided through the city. Motorways are reduced and walkways are expanded. As last this approach wants to enhance the functions in already existing buildings. This guarantees a boost to the quality of life in the city. On the basis of using clusters, empty buildings are given new functions and the city becomes more attractive to tourists and residents.
