


Multifunctional workshops hall - ground floor

o2 strategic facade opening towards the east to establish a clear urban frontage and strengthen the connection to the newly developed entrance of the village centre Redefined entrance situation

characterized by a striking and contemporary architectural language 03 Opening the facade to the south to align the cafe spatially and func-

tionally with the adjacent southern Insertion of new window elements

o4 Selective removal of the existing ceiling structure in the northern part of the building to create a workshop hall wich is directly connected to the entrance and the outside of the building


Formation of a vertically open, multifunctional workshop hall spanning the entire building height

o5 Partly Removal of glass blocks in

the facade of the workshop hall area to improve natural lighting and visual connection to the new village center. The glass blocks will be reused later inside the building, e.g., as interior walls or partition elements Insertion of new window elements

o6 Insertion of a new lightweight timber structure to subdivide workshop and office areas. Formation of a


secondary envelope layer for thermal




Longitudinal section - hall M1:200




Longitudinal section - workshops M1:200
